

Dear Design Professional,

Following the release of Intel® Quartus® Prime software v20.1 on April 13, 2020, support for Arm* Development Studio 5 (Arm* DS-5) was dropped from the Intel Quartus Prime Pro and Standard edition software.

The following development kit part numbers include an Arm DS-5 license serial number – these have become invalid after the Intel Quartus Prime software v20.1 release.

ESW-DS-FIX must be purchased separately to receive an Arm* Development Studio for Intel® SoC FPGA (Arm* DS for Intel SoC FPGA) license serial number, which will be the replacement product for Arm DS-5.

Customers who have purchased any of the above development kits before April 13, 2020 will continue to have access to Arm DS-5 with the Intel Quartus Prime software v19.4 and previous releases, with support for up to one year under the terms of Arm's license agreement.
