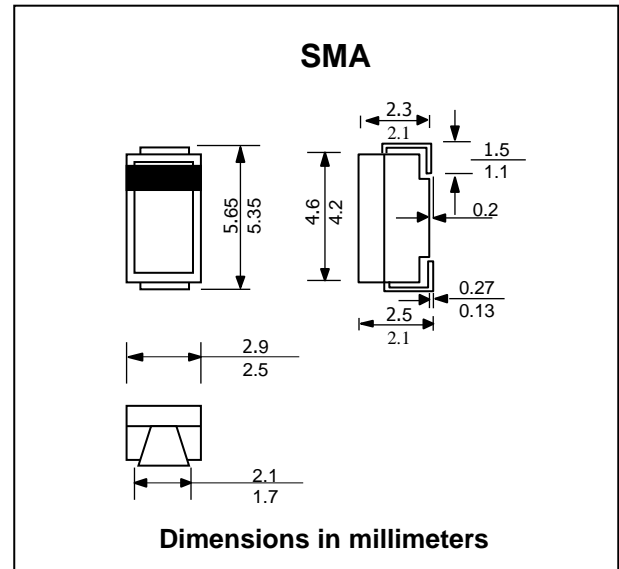

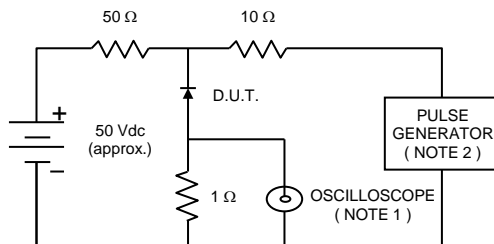

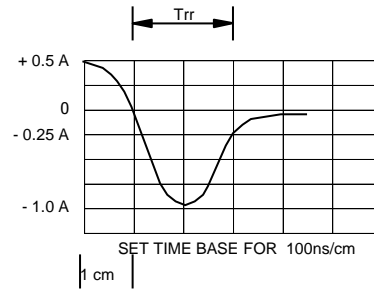

## RATING AND CHARACTERISTIC CURVES ( SR1R )

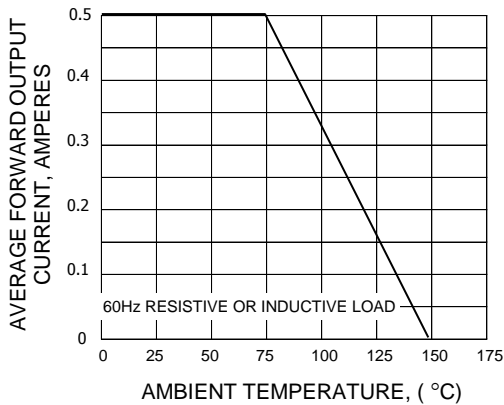
**FIG.1 - REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM**



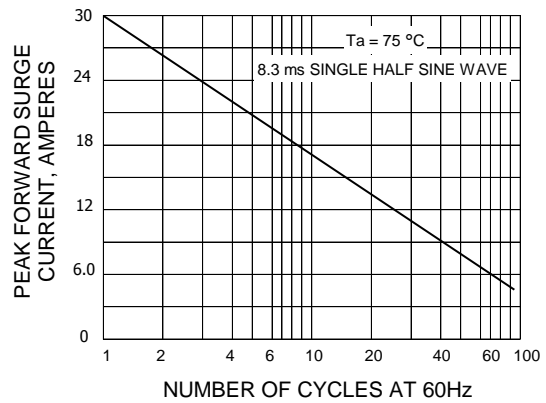
NOTES : 1. Rise Time = 7 ns max., Input Impedance = 1 megaohm, 22 pF.

 3. All Resistors = Non-inductive Types.



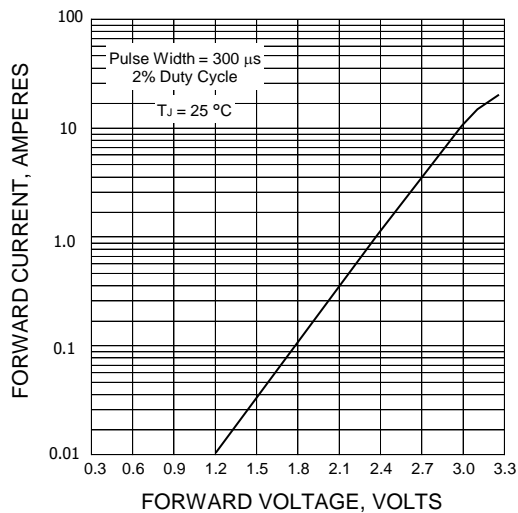
**FIG.2 - DERATING CURVE FOR OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT**
