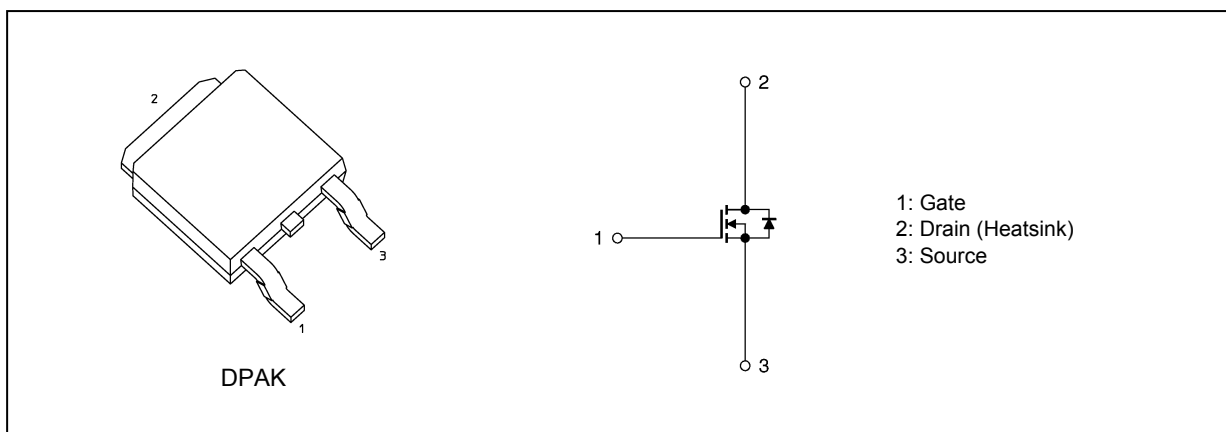
## 1. Applications

## 2. Features

- (1) Fast reverse recovery time:  $t_{rr} = 65 \text{ ns}$  (typ.)
- (2) Low drain-source on-resistance:  $R_{DS(ON)} = 0.84 \Omega$  (typ.)  
by using Super Junction Structure : DTMOS
- (3) Easy to control Gate switching
- (4) Enhancement mode:  $V_{th} = 3 \text{ to } 4.5 \text{ V}$  ( $V_{DS} = 10 \text{ V}$ ,  $I_D = 0.23 \text{ mA}$ )

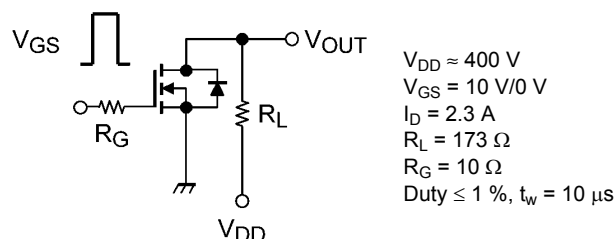


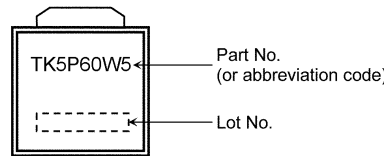
Fig. 6.2.1 Switching Time Test Circuit

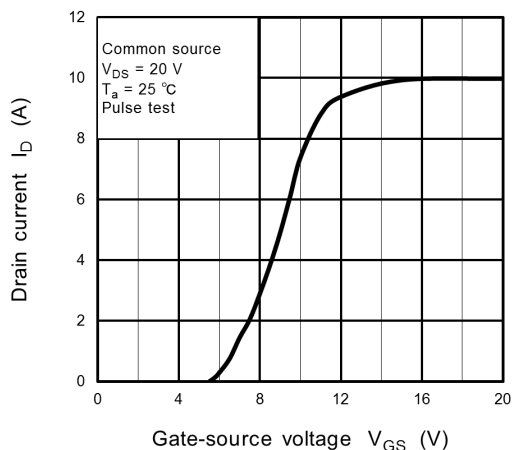

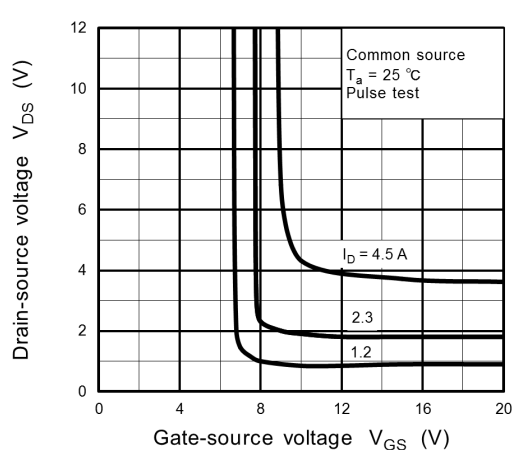
**Fig. 8.1  $I_D - V_{DS}$**



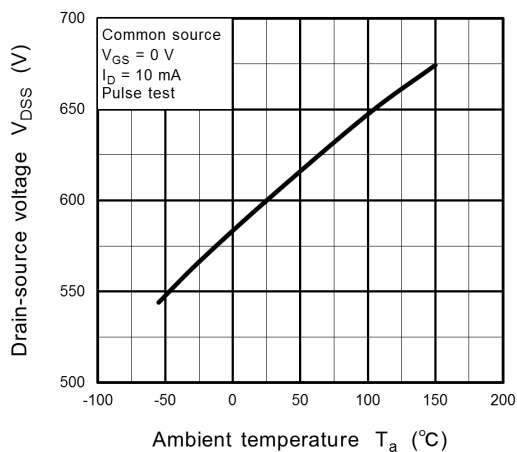
**Fig. 8.2  $I_D - V_{DS}$**



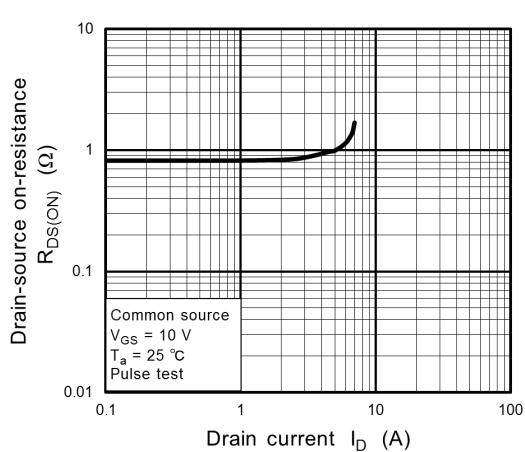
**Fig. 8.3  $I_D - V_{GS}$**

**Fig. 8.6  $R_{DS(ON)} - I_D$**

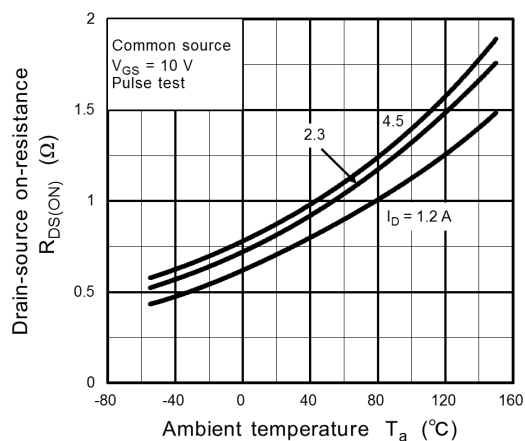
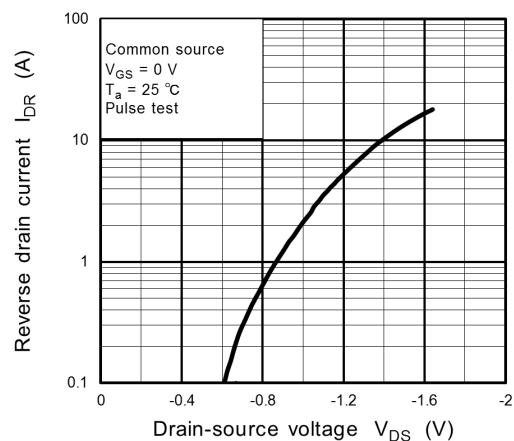
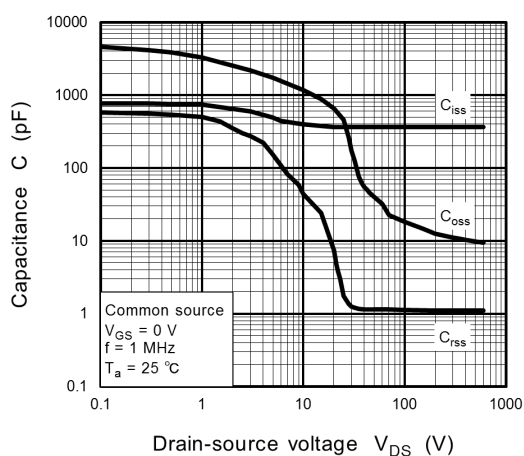
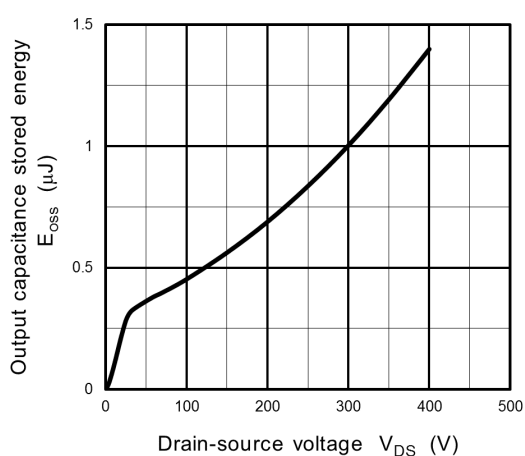
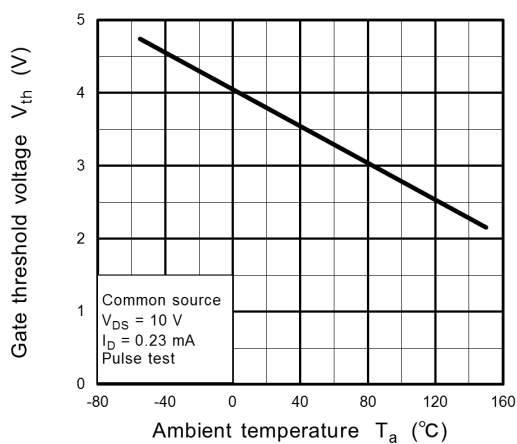
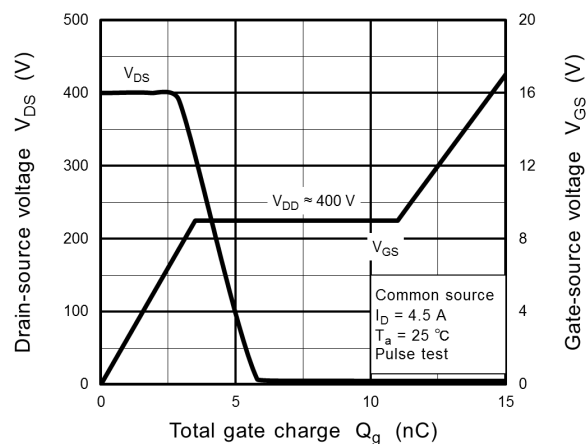
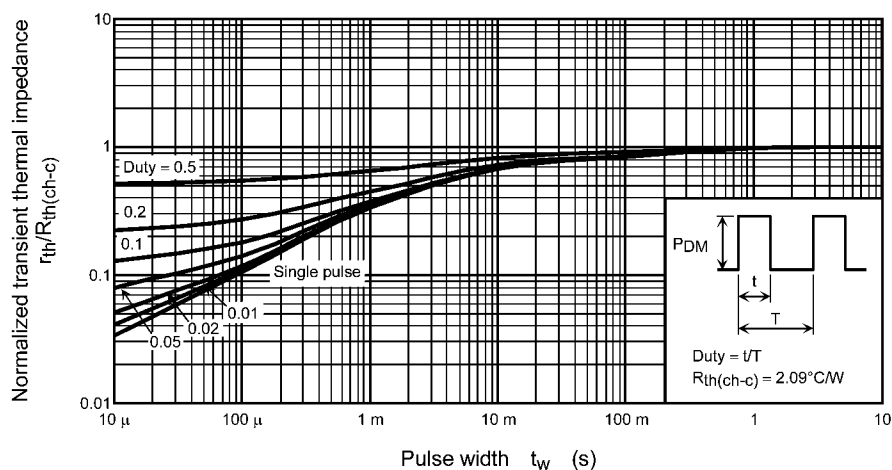
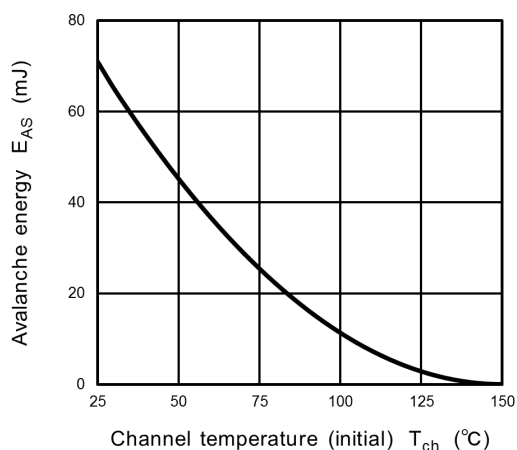
Fig. 8.7  $R_{DS(ON)} - T_a$ Fig. 8.8  $I_{DR} - V_{DS}$ Fig. 8.9  $C - V_{DS}$ Fig. 8.10  $E_{OSS} - V_{DS}$ Fig. 8.11  $V_{th} - T_a$ 

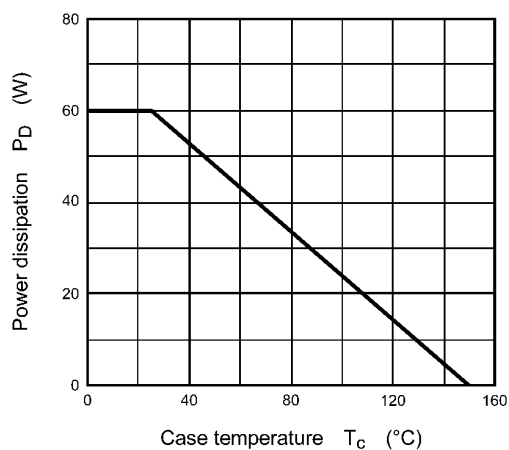
Fig. 8.12 Dynamic Input/Output Characteristics



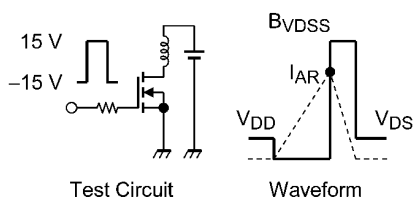
**Fig. 8.13  $r_{th} - t_w$**

(Guaranteed Maximum)

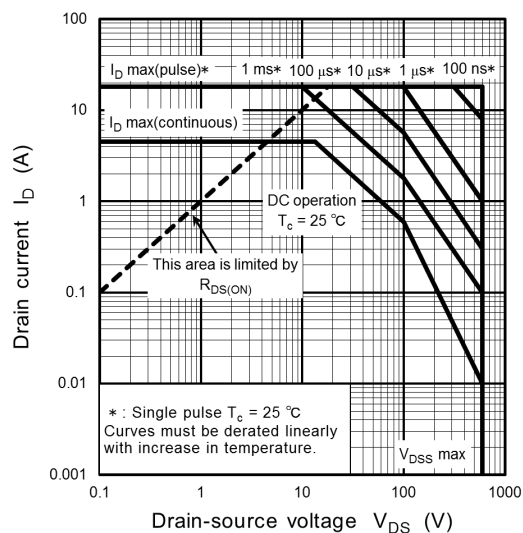


**Fig. 8.15  $P_D - T_c$**

**Fig. 8.16 Test Circuit/Waveform**

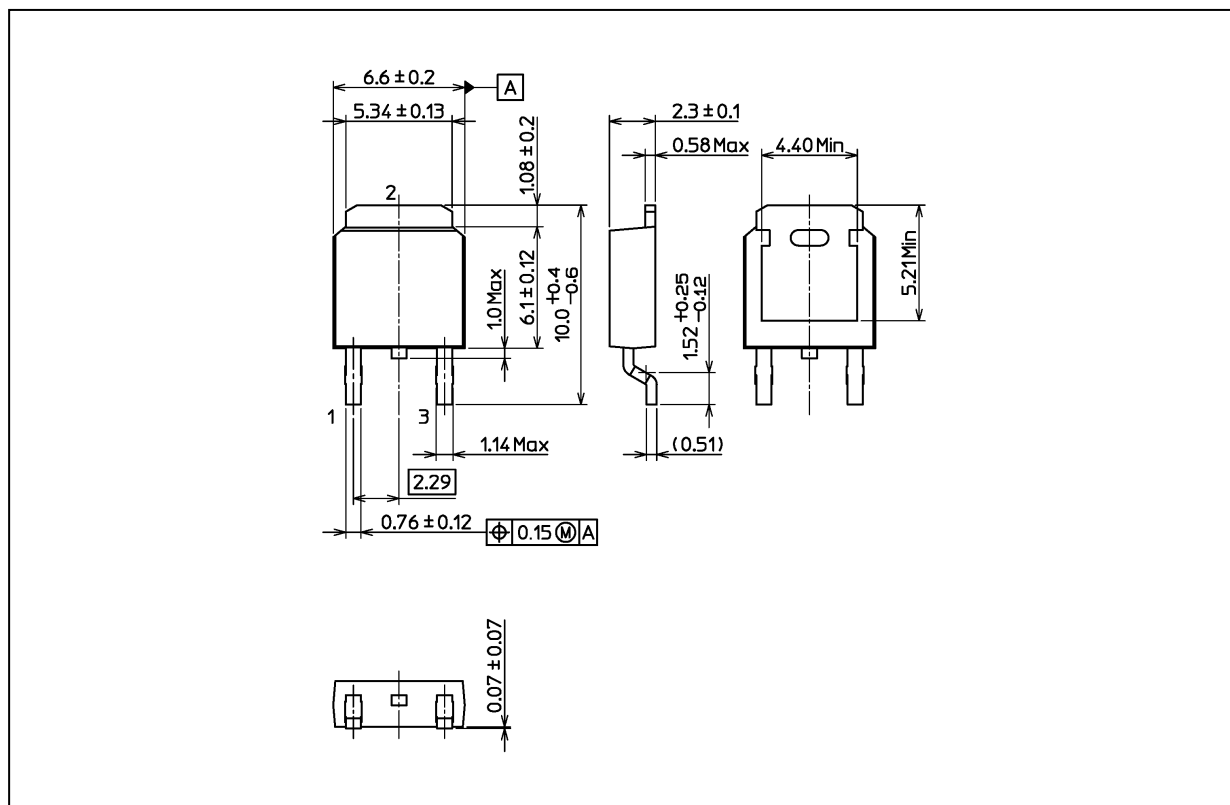


**Fig. 8.17 Safe Operating Area
